The criteria for the evaluation will be as follows:

The submission of all the requested documents is mandatory to be admitted to the following evaluation of the Technical and Economic proposal

Administrative check
1 – Non Bankruptcy proof
2 – Anti-corruption Policy
3 – Code of Ethics
4 – A valid chamber of commerce registration, or equivalent document, of the Service Provider (produced in original format and in any case, in English)
5 – The Tender Submission Form (annex III)

The quality of Technical and Economic Evaluation tenders will be evaluated in accordance with the award criteria and the associated weighting as detailed in the evaluation grid below.

The formula for Economic offer evaluation is:

$$ES = CP/EP \times 100$$

where ES is the Economic Score, CP is the value of the Cheapest Proposal and EP is the value of the Economic Proposal under consideration.

The Total evaluation score is:

$$ET = 0,40 \times ET1 + 0,30 \times ET2 + 0,30 \times ES.$$

The contract will be awarded to the tenderer offering the best value for money, taking into account the awarding criteria listed above. No award criteria and sub-criteria other than those detailed above will be used to evaluate the tender.

The applicant obtaining the highest combined technical and economical score will be invited to a negotiation and will receive a draft contract according to Italian law.
