



- Formalize an existing Nexus-relevant basin committee, Ecuador

Nexus Action Plan Niger Basin

- Construction of the Fomi Dam and ancillary structures, Guinea
- Nexus operation of the Fomi dam, regional
- Consolidating access to water-energy-food securities in resettled areas of the Kandadji Dam Project, Niger
- Soil and water conservation to decrease erosion and sedimentation in the Niger basin for water and land security, Mali
- Increasing WEF securities in agriculture using a nexus approach in small scale irrigation projects, Mali and Niger
- Improving the navigability of the Niger and its major tributaries for increased trade and food security, regional
- Climate resilient fish farming and transformation for increased food security, Mali
- Increasing food security and water efficiency through improved livestock management, Chad

Nexus Action Plan Niger Basin

- Protection of ecosystem services to increase WEF securities in humid zones, Mali
- Coordinated dam operation in the Niger basin for water, energy and food security, regional
- Securing WEF resources through forestry interventions, Ivory Coast
- Water, Energy and Food protection through the anaerobic digestion of fecal sludge, Burkina Faso
- Establishment of a project preparation facility for water energy and food security projects in the basin/region, regional

Nexus Action Plan Central Asia

- Programme Direction 1: Integrated Water Resource Use:
 - Project 1.1: Modernization and introduction of SCADA and sustainable exploitation of hydrotechnical facilities in the Syr Darya River Basin;
 - Project 1.2: Enhancing the reclamation condition of irrigated land in the Amu Darya and Syr Darya River Basins;
 - Project 1.3: Safety of dams and other hydrotechnical facilities in Central Asia: development of the potential and regional cooperation;
 - Project 1.4: Improvement of the WRM in the Amu Darya River Basin through the rehabilitation and modernization of the water facilities and interstate legislative framework.
- Programme Direction 2: Environment Protection:
 - Project 2.1: Rehabilitation of the Aral Sea ecosystem to combat desertification and land degradation;
 - Project 2.2: Integrated disaster risk management in the Aral Sea Basin.

The Nexus Regional Dialogue Central Asia

- Programme Direction 3: Social and Economic Development:
 - Project 3.1: Ensuring sustainable water and power supply to rural communities of Central Asian countries;
 - Project 3.2: Integrated development of eco-and agro-tourism with elements of ethno-tourism in protected natural areas of the Aral Sea basin.
